

FOR THOSE WHO PURCHASED COMPLETE JUNIOR TAP SYLLABUS

1. In all grades, the word "Branch" has been replaced by "CDTA". For example, in each grade students will show a select number of combinations set by "CDTA" (was formerly set by "the Branch").

Primary and Grade One - now say: Candidates show 3 Combinations set annually by CDTA (see CDTA website) and 2 additional Combinations to be selected by Teacher Grades Two and Three - now say: Candidates show 4 Combinations set annually by CDTA (see CDTA website) and 3 additional Combinations to be selected by Teacher

- 2. All Junior Graded exams may now be conducted by Teacher or Examiner (Teacher's choice). Prior to this it was the Branch's choice. (There is a place to indicate this on the actual Examination Entry Form Part B.
- Under Terminology, beginning in Grade One, it now states: At the discretion of each <u>teacher</u>, definitions of, or questions on, terminology may be asked.

This means that teachers can have their students give the syllabus definition of each term in the exam, or just know the description and term well enough to answer any questions relating to it. (Prior to this it was a Branch choice what to ask.)

4. In <u>Grade One</u> - Under Standard Combinations - pg 9 - "Simple Essence" to be shown <u>front, side, and back</u> (formerly said "or back"). The intention is for the student to know and show all three ways in exam.

Pg 12 - Definition of **Leap** - "Province" info removed. Now says: "Spring into the air from the ball of one foot, landing on the ball of the other foot."

5. In <u>Grade Two</u> - pg 17 - Combination #10 (Rhythm Section in three styles)
- now states:

Music written especially for the Rhythm Section must be used. Music is available from the CDTA website (Grade 2 Music File).

- 6. In <u>Grade Three</u> pg 24 Combination #7 Error corrected. Changed to say "hop R" on first count 2 (formerly said "hop L").
- 7. DVDs are no longer available. Instead, video files for each grade are available for purchase and download from <u>www.cdtanational.ca</u>
- 8. Optional Music for all grades is also available for purchase and download from <u>www.cdtanational.ca</u>
- 9. Timings / groupings have been added to Junior Medal Test notes at all levels.

10. <u>Please note</u>: Candidates for Junior Bronze, Silver and Gold Medal tests may be entered as a group of one, two, or three candidates, but each one will take turns performing each combination / time steps individually. May then leave room (and change costume - optional) and re-enter one at a time to show dance and/or improv (when examiner rings bell).

- 2. All Senior level exams, Grades Four to Advanced, are conducted by Examiner. This is now stated at the beginning of each grade.
- Under Terminology, in all grades, it states:
 At the discretion of each <u>teacher</u>, definitions of, or questions on, terminology may be asked.

This means that teachers can have their students give the syllabus definition of each term in the exam, or just know the description and term well enough to answer any questions relating to it.
