Best of luck to all teachers who are preparing their students for these exams! We will also be conducting 4 professional exams from now to June.

Our next deadlines for exam entries are:

* 6 weeks prior to requested exam date - for exams to be held Jul 1-Oct 15. * September 1 - for exams to be held from Oct 15-Nov 15.

A few reminders when entering...

Please make sure to submit both Part A and Part B 2024 entry forms when entering exams. Also, remember to read over the August 2024 edition of our CDTA Student Examinations Handbook and for professional exams, the CDTA Professional Examination Handbook. There is lots of important info in each. We will be reviewing these documents and fees in July. The "August 2025" edition and paperwork will be released beginning of August and will come into effect September 1.



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
